The society has finished its two-year project to survey and catalogue (more than 270) wells across the parish and has published its findings in a book, "Rainford's wells: a record and history" which can be bought from the society for just £7.

Village War Memorial

As mentioned on page 1, the Chairman's fundraising for 2016/17 is to build a War Memorial outside the Village Hall.

This is an ambitious project and we will be raising funds in a number of ways, including social events and a grand draw for which tickets are now on sale at £1 each in books of five.

There are many great prizes, including vouchers kindly donated by local businesses and a top prize of £200 cash.

If you would like to make a donation to the fund for the War Memorial or purchase draw tickets please contact the Clerk to the Parish Council at the Village Hall on 884709 or your local Parish Councillor.

In the meantime we have an interest free loan so we can get on with this work. We will be keeping people informed of progress via a new Facebook page dedicated to the War Memorial.

The War Memorial is being supplied by Ormsby of Scarisbrick. It will be Indian stone and the base has already been laid.

We aim to have the War Memorial in place for this year's Remembrance Sunday (13 November 2016), although work will probably not be fully completed until 2017.

The plan is to have War Memorial consecrated the week before Remembrance Sunday, on Sunday 6 November at 12 noon.

Rainford in Bloom

By now you won't have failed to notice that 5 July was this year's judging day by North West in Bloom. In the week of the judging, our Facebook page registered over 7,000 "post reach"!

The Rainford in Bloom initiative was originally set up by Rainford Parish Council but now is a separate entity which operates through a steering group of residents and Parish Councillors. Bloom has expanded this year (the second year of entry into the North West in Bloom Awards) and in addition to the Village Centre, the judges also visited the Junction, including the allotments; Hill Top; Crank and King's Moss; and the three village primary schools

Judges John and Julie were welcomed to the Village Hall by a beautiful display arranged by Norma Cunliffe of Rainford Flower Club and after touring the village enjoyed lunch courtesy of the Rainford Welfare & Old Folk's Treat Committee

We have received notification our entries have been nominated for awards for 2016, and we will find out if we have been successful at the end of October when we will attend the presentation event in Southport.



Rainford in Bloom also held a "Best front garden" competition and received over 50 nominations. From the entries the team announced at the Rainford Show:
